Journal of Samuel E. Woolley

27 November 1914

"... I went to Centerville to visit Uncle John he is feeling well and seems to have good health, better than he did for years past. I had supper with him and read some important documents that he has in his possession. ... have had a pleasant day, and feel well repaid for going to see Uncle John. he is a grand old man and I feel that he will come out all right - some of these days."

13 Jan. 1915

"Met Sister Edith Hunter, she told me of someone high up that has been questioning her whether I had advised people to take more wives while she was in the Mission."

19 January 1915

"Lorin C. Woolley came and seen me administered to my and I felt better."

22 Jan. 1915

"Lorin C. Woolley stayed all night with us."
