*Jacob Cochrane*, the notorious preacher and leader of a new party of religious zealots in this country, has been sentenced, by the Supreme Court now sitting at Alfred, to 13 days solitary imprisonment, and four years hard labor in the state's prison, for the crime of adultery, of which he was convicted before the Supreme Court at York, in May last, and absconded before the passing of the sentence. On the other three indictments, for lewdness, fornication, and adultery, he has not yet been tried.
